

2024 SideBurn RV Policy

Every vehicle through the gates of the event needs a vehicle pass (motorcycles excluded).

You will have the opportunity to purchase one (1) vehicle pass when your ticket offer is made and can be purchased alongside your ticket or added later.

The Vehicle Pass fees are as follows:

- <u>\$25 + fees</u> -- all private passenger vehicles. For example, cars, trucks, minivans, SUVs, OR box trucks of any size are needed to support a theme camp's operations (with the approval of the City Department).
- \$200 + fees -- Any non-private passenger vehicle to live/sleep in. For example, bus conversions, travel trailers, teardrop campers, pop-up campers, hybrid trailers, camper vans or conversion vans (Class B motorhome), Class C motorhomes OR a box truck not intended to support a theme camp's operations.

All vehicles and trailers must have a valid license plate. Ontario Towing Laws

We do not guarantee that your vehicle will be able to be driven or parked in the event area.

Access to the event site beyond the RV parking area close to the entry gate will be weather permitting, large vehicles are very likely to damage the road in bad weather, or worst of all – get stuck in the field.

All vehicles large or small assume the responsibility of paying their towing fees if their vehicle becomes stuck. All vehicles must be removed from the site no later than three hours past the end of the event.
